RACE CONTROLLER IN USE

To run a race, all drivers must join the current race, they can do so by touching any part of the race controller except for the blue 'Show Records' button.

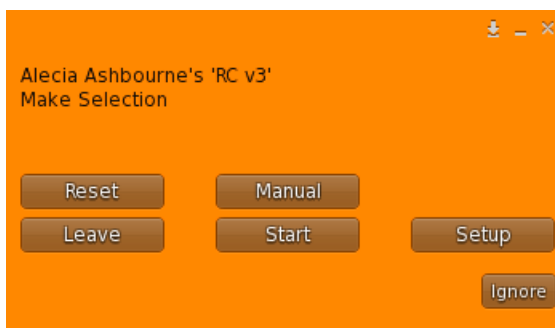
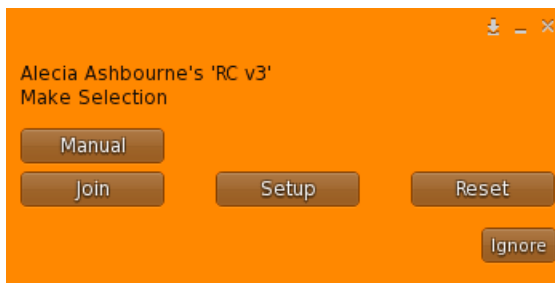
From the menu, choose "Join".

After a driver has joined the race, the menu auto reconfigures with two additional options, "Leave" and "Start". "Leave" removes that driver from the race and "Reset" removes all drivers and resets the lap count to default, "Start" starts the race.

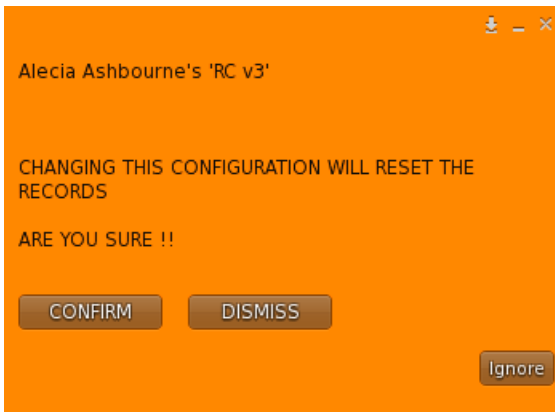
When the race is started, no drivers can leave or join the race.

All racers have the option to join leave, reset or start the race, only the owner can choose "Setup". "Reset" can be used if the RC bugs out for any reason, or there is a false start. A false start occurs if any driver jumps the start timer. The start gate turns red, and the race is stopped.

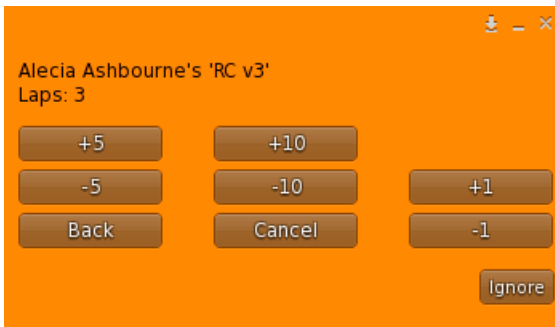
"Manual" offers the url to this online manual.



Choosing "Setup" (owner only option) opens a warning and confirmation menu. Changing the lap count will delete the records for the present lap configuration, and so requires your confirmation. If you confirm, then the lap count menu will present.



The default lap count is three, meaning there are three laps required to complete the race. You can add to or subtract from the default lap count in this menu. The current lap count is displayed in the menu dialogue, and also announced on the public chat channel, and at the start of the race.



When the race is started, there is a five second countdown, then the announcement "Go". Race lights change from red to green, and the start gate changes from neutral to green.

When the race is complete, the RC can be touched again, it will reset, and display the race winners in order. After some time, it will return to its default state and display the race records.

Any racer taking a shortcut, and not completing the circuit check points, will have a lap added, and will have to complete another lap to complete the race.

The blue "Show Records" button if pressed will force the RC to display the historic race records.
